The Canal Road Westbound Lane Project Pre-Construction schedule is as follows:

- Signs and Maintenance of Traffic equipment installation to begin this week.
- Existing striping black-out, temporary striping and concrete removal in front of Cosmos to occur the week of April 17th.
- Resurfacing to begin April 24th, immediately followed by striping.

Project will result in four 11 FT wide lanes with 2 FT shoulders.

It is fully anticipated that the lanes will be open and fully functioning by Memorial Day.

Lane closures can only occur Sunday through Thursday between the hours of 9:00pm and 6:00am.

Speed limit anticipated to remain the same.

Requests for valve box and manhole cover resets to be provided shortly with 72 hour notice.

Page 2 is the flyer that needs to be posted where appropriate.
